



BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING DIRECT CONTRACTING AS AN ALTERNATIVE MODE OF PROCUREMENT

RESOLUTION NO. <u>021</u> - Series of 2017 JOB ORDER NO. 2017-05-0074

WHEREAS, Section 48, Rule XVI Alternative Methods of Procurement of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the 'Government Procurement Reform Act' provides that in order to promote economy. And efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement which are Limited Source Bidding Direct Contracting, Repeat Order, Shopping and Negotiated Procurement, provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained:

WHEREAS, Section 50 provides further that DIRECT CONTRACTING or single source procurement is a method of procurement of goods that does not require elaborate Bidding Documents. The supplier is simply asked to submit a price quotation or a pro-forma invoice together with the condition of sale. Direct contracting may be resorted under any of the following conditions:

- a) Procurement of goods of proprietary nature which can be obtained only from the proprietary source;
- b) When the procurement of critical components from a specific supplier is-a condition precedent to hold a contractor to guarantee its project performance, in accordance with the provisions of its contract;
- c) Those sold by an exclusive dealer or manufacturer which does not have subdealers selling at lower prices and for which no suitable substitute can be obtained at more advantageous terms;

WHEREAS, upon review of the attached Job Order No. 2017-05-0074 indicating the item/s that is/are included in the current Annual Procurement Plan (APP) and Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP), and that the supplier's Certificate of Sole Distributorship/other documents as exclusive dealer or manufacturer/ supplier's documents like patent, trade secrets and copyrights and the condition of sale to support the procurement, the BAC finds that the above conditions for Direct Contracting are satisfied.
