**PB BAC RESOLUTION NO. 001 – SERIES OF 2017**  
**BID NO 001-17**

**RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO 8BTSI CORPORATION AS  
HAVING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) AND  
RECOMMENDING TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY THE APPROVAL THEREOF**

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**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the pertinent provisions of the Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), the Bids and Awards Committee was created pursuant to PBS-BBS Memorandum Order No. 003 – series of 2017, ensuring transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications;

**WHEREAS**, on April 05, 2017, the Invitation to Bid for Bid No. 001-17, Public Bidding for the **ONE (1) LOT - PURCHASE OF BROADCAST TRANSMITTERS, ANTENNA SYSTEM AND ACCESSORIES** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **Fourteen Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 14,200,000.00)** through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) 2016 was advertised and published in a newspaper of general nationwide circulation (Philippine Star) and posted the same in PhilGEPS, PBS-BBS Website and in conspicuous place in the PBS-BBS premises;

**WHEREAS**, five (5) prospective bidders namely, 8BTSI CORPORATION, COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC., FEL-ITAL ELECTRONICS, ACCESS INTERNATIONAL and MS. ARLENE PITEL ZARATAN viewed the Invitation to Bid and Bidding Documents at the PhilGEPS Website;

**WHEREAS**, four (4) prospective bidders have purchased the Bidding Documents namely, 8BTSI CORPORATION, COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC., FEL-ITAL ELECTRONICS and ACCESS INTERNATIONAL;

**WHEREAS**, similarly in compliance with the pertinent provisions of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184, representatives from the Commission on Audit (COA), as well as observers from the private sectors, were invited to observe and witness the conduct of the Pre-Bid Conference and Opening of Bids as scheduled;

**WHEREAS**, a Pre-Bid Conference was conducted last April 18, 2017 at 10:00am with six (6) prospective bidders in attendance namely SWR PHILIPPINES, MS. ARLENE PITEL ZARATAN, 8BTSI CORPORATION, COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC., FEL-ITAL ELECTRONICS and ACCESS INTERNATIONAL,

**WHEREAS**, on May 11, 2017, three (3) prospective bidders namely, FEL-ITAL ELECTRONICS, 8BTSI CORPORATION and COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC. submitted their respective sealed Eligibility and Technical Documents as well as their



Financial Component Documents before the 10:00 am deadline and simultaneously, the BAC conducted the Opening of Bids while ACCESS INTERNATIONAL submitted a letter informing the BAC that they will no longer participate in the opening of bids. Sequence of Bid opening was based on the time it was received and submitted to the BAC;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC first opened the Eligibility and Technical Documents of FEL-ITAL ELECTRONICS, its itemized contents were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector, during the course of the evaluation, it was discovered that it failed on one (1) of its Class "A" Document -- *"Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided for in Sections 23.4.1.3 and 23.4.2.4 of IRR, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents in the case of Goods. Amount of completed contracts, adjusted by the Bidder to current prices using PSA's consumer price index, if necessary for the purpose of meeting the SLCC requirement; A single contract that is similar to this project, at least fifty percent (50%) of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)"* -- it was found to be Incomplete or patently insufficient and has FAILED the Bid Evaluation and was declared **"INELIGIBLE"**. Subsequently the BAC issued a Notice of Ineligibility to the prospective bidder and informed the prospective bidder that they may file for a motion for reconsideration within three (3) calendar days upon receipt of the notice;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC proceeded to open the Eligibility and Technical Documents envelope of 8BTSI CORPORATION, its itemized contents were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector, its itemized contents were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector and found to have PASSED and SUFFICIENT and was declared **"ELIGIBLE"**;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC proceeded to open the Eligibility and Technical Documents envelope of COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY INC., its itemized contents were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector and found to have PASSED and SUFFICIENT and was declared **"ELIGIBLE"**;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC proceeded to open the Financial Document of 8BTSI CORPORATION and COMPOSITE INC., their financial proposals were opened and read aloud and subsequently shown thru multi-media projector;

**WHEREAS**, the bidding process was completed and the BAC declared the bid of 8BTSI CORPORATION in the amount of Thirteen Million Six Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand Pesos (PhP13,669,000.00) as the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) followed by COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC., in the amount of Thirteen Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP13,850,000.00);

**WHEREAS**, the BAC in the same meeting discussed with the bidders the guidelines for the post-qualification stage and informed 8BTSI CORPORATION representatives that the BAC Group will conduct a post-qualification and within five (5) calendar days the bidder need to submit the required pertinent documents stated in the Bidding Documents;

**WHEREAS**, on May 12, 2017, the BAC issued a Notice of Post-Qualification to 8BTSI CORPORATION and informed them within five (5) calendar days they are required to submit their latest income and business tax returns and other appropriate licences and permits required by law and stated in the Bidding Documents and the BAC will conduct an inspection of its Eligibility and Technical Component Documents,



counterchecked said documents with the original documents and inspected the office premises;

**WHEREAS**, upon submission of 8BTSI CORPORATION of its post-qualification documents, on May 15, 2017, the composite group of selected BAC, TWG and Secretariat proceeded to the office of 8BTSI CORP. and conducted the post qualification inspection of its Eligibility and Technical Component Documents, counterchecked said documents with the original documents and inspected the office premises;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC in a meeting held last May 16, 2017, the composite group presented the Post Qualification Documents of 8BTSI CORPORATION and likewise presented the checklist of post qualification requirements which were verified and validated and all were found to be true and correct and in accordance with the requirements and inspection activities undertaken jointly by the BAC, TWG and Secretariat;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, with the foregoing premises considered, we the members of the Bureau of Broadcast Services – Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend to the Approving Authority to declare **8BTSI CORPORATION** as having the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB)** for the delivery, installation and commissioning of Broadcast Transmitters, Antenna System and Accessories for the Bureau of Broadcast Services (BBS); and

**RESOLVE FURTHER**, that the Bureau of Broadcast Services – Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) hereby **RECOMMEND** to the Approving Authority the approval of this resolution and the issuance of Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and Purchase Contract to **8BTSI CORPORATION** for the delivery, installation and commissioning of the following: One (1) Unit – 20KW FM Solid State Broadcast Transmitter, One (1) Unit – 5KW FM Solid State Broadcast Transmitter, One (1) Set - 6 bay FM Antenna System and Coaxial Transmission Cable, One (1) Unit – Dehydrator and Two (2) Units - 40KVA Automatic Voltage Regulator (AVR) in the amount of **Thirteen Million Six Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand Pesos (PhP 13,669,000.00)** in accordance with the provisions of signed contract of services and the guidelines under the Government Procurement Reform Act as approved and adopted by the Government Procurement and Policy Board (GPPB).


