BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) RESOLUTION DECLARING 168 SECURITY, INC. AS HAVING THE SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE ONE (1) LOT – CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY AGENCY SERVICES FOR TWELVE (12) MONTHS AND RECOMMENDING TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY THE APPROVAL THEREOF

WHEREAS, there is an approved Purchase Request (P.R.) No. **2018-10-0391** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), in the amount of *Nineteen Million One Hundred Eleven Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 19,111,500.00)* for the supply of fifty five (55) security guards as listed hereunder;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) was authorized to resort to Public Bidding in accordance with the provision of Rule IV, Section 10, Competitive Bidding of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act which states that all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding, except as provided in Rule XVI of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC was created in accordance with BBS Memorandum Order No. 006 series of 2018;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC convened on 12 October 2018 to conduct a pre-procurement conference with the End-User in accordance with the provision of Section 20 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 15 October 2018, the BBS-BAC as mandated by Republic Act No 9184, in order to maintain its security services for all its offices nationwide, posted the Invitation to Bid for the **One (1) Lot – Contract for the Provision of Security Agency Services for twelve (12) months (Bid No. 008-18)** in the Philippine Government Electronics Procurement System (PHILGEPS), on conspicuous place at the premises of the BBS and posted the same in Philippine Star, a newspaper of general nationwide circulation;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, seven (7) prospective bidders viewed the Invitation to Bid at the PHILGEPS Website namely; CIRCA SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION, INC., NORTHCOM SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION AGENCY, INC., APL SECURITY SERVICES CORPORATION, AGILEX SECURITY AGENCY, INC., 168 SECURITY, INC., GRAND MERITUS SECURITY AGENCY, INC. and HACKETT SECURITY AGENCY ;

WHEREAS, for the purposes of transparency and good governance and pursuant to Section 13 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invited three (3) observers to witness the pre-bid conference on 23 October 2018 and the opening of bids on 06 November 2018 namely; MR. CRISANTO FRIANEZA, Secretary General of Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, MR. AMADOR ASTUDILLO, President of Procurement Watch and MS. ANNABELLE F. DE VERA, State Auditor III/Audit Team Leader in BBS of Commission on Audit;

WHEREAS, on 22 October 2018, the BBS-BAC posted Supplemental /Bid Bulletin No. 001 in PHILGEPS to give clarifications and additional instruction in the bid document particularly in the security guards deployment and day/night shifting schedule;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC scheduled the Pre-Bid Conference on 23 October 2018 at 11:00AM in order that the BBS-BAC may clarify issues which the prospective bidders might raise, the said

Pre-Bid Conference was attended by the following, namely; 168 SECURITY INC. and GRAND MERITUS SECURITY AGENCY, INC.;

WHEREAS, One (1) prospective bidder namely; 168 SECURITY INC. purchased the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, on 06 November 2018 at 1:30PM, the Bids BBS-BAC scheduled the Opening of Bids, 168 SECURITY INC. attended and submitted its Eligibility and Technical Components Documents as well as its Financial Component Document;

WHEREAS, the bidding process was completed within the day and found the Eligibility and Technical Components Documents of 168 SECURITY INC. to have PASSED and was declared ELIGIBLE after its itemized content were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector, after which its Financial Component Document was opened and read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector, and was found to be RESPONSIVE BID;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC declared the bid of 168 SECURITY INC. in the amount of *Eighteen Million Nine Hundred Seventeen Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Two Pesos and 28/100 centavos (PhP 18,917,492.28)* as the SINGLE RESPONSIVE BID;

WHEREAS, on the same meeting, the BBS-BAC informed the bidder from 168 SECURITY INC. to submit their Post-Qualification Documents within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days and in addition, the BBS-BAC discussed the parameters for the post-qualification stage and selected the composite group of selected BAC, Technical Working Group (TWG) and Secretariat who will conduct the said stage;

WHEREAS, the bidder from 168 SECURITY INC. informed the BAC they will submit the required Post-Qualification documents within the week and they are available for the conduct of Post-Qualification inspection in their office premises on 09 November 2018;

WHEREAS, the composite group of selected BAC, TWG and Secretariat on 09 November 2018 at 8:00AM, proceeded to the office of 168 SECURITY INC. and conducted the post qualification inspection of its Eligibility and Technical Components Documents and Post Qualification Documents and counterchecked the same with the original documents. The team likewise inspected the office premises;

WHEREAS, on 16 November 2018. a meeting was held, the BBS-BAC Secretariat presented the Checklist of Post-Qualification Requirements which were verified and validated and all were found to be true and correct and in accordance with the requirements and inspection activities. The financial document was likewise reviewed and found to be in order;

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, we the members of the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC), hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to declare **168 SECURITY INC.** as having the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) for the supply of fifty five (55) security guards for all Bureau of Broadcast Services (BBS) facilities nationwide (NCR, CAR, Region I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII and ARMM) for the One (1) Lot - Contract for the Provision of Security Agency Services for twelve (12) months; and

RESOLVE FURTHER, that the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) recommends to the Approving Authority the approval of this resolution, the subsequent issuance of the Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and to enter into an Agreement with **168 SECURITY INC.** for the supply of fifty five (55) security guards in the amount of **EIGHTEEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY TWO PESOS and 28/100 CENTAVOS (PhP 18,917,492.28)** in accordance with the provisions of the signed contract of services and the Guidelines under the Government Procurement Reform Act, as approved and adopted by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB).




