BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) RESOLUTION DECLARING MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA) AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE QUOTATION AND RECOMMENDING TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY THE APPROVAL THEREOF

WHEREAS, there is an approved Purchase Request (P.R.) No. **2018-06-0248** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of *One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,500,000.00)* for the procurement of following items;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created in accordance with BBS Memorandum Order No. 006 series of 2018;

WHEREAS, the said Purchase Request is included in the Annual Procurement Plan of the Philippine Broadcasting Service-Bureau Services (PBS-BBS) for 2018;

WHEREAS, the BAC received from the End-User the purchase request and other appropriate document/s;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) conducted two (2) public biddings for the One (1) Lot - Supply and Delivery of One (1) Unit Brand New Passenger Van both public biddings failed. The first scheduled Opening of Bids for Bid No. 003-18 was held last 10 April 2018, no bidders purchased the bidding documents and participated, while the second scheduled Opening of Bids for Bid No. 005-18 was held last 21 May 2018, the lone bidder failed on one (1) of its eligibility requirements –“*Technical Specifications: Item A*”– it was found to be patently insufficient and has FAILED the Bid Evaluation and was declared “INELGIBLE”;

WHEREAS, Section 35.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184, provides that the BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when (a) No bids are received; and (b) all prospective bidders are declared ineligible;

WHEREAS, Section 35.5 provides that should there occur a second failure of bidding, the Procuring Entity may resort to negotiated procurement, as provided for in Section 53.1 of the Revised IRR;

WHEREAS, Section 53 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, allows an agency to resort to Negotiated Procurement, a method of procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services whereby the Procuring Entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally and financially capable supplier, contractor or consultant;

WHEREAS, Section 53.1 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 allows an agency to resort to **TWO FAILED BIDDINGS** where there has been failure of competitive bidding or limited source bidding for the second time as provided in Section 35 of the Act and the Revised IRR;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted a mandatory review of the terms, conditions, specifications and cost estimates as prescribed in Section 35 of the IRR, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) together with its Secretariat, TWG and End-User agreed to revised the technical specifications and to adjust the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) from the amount of One Million Four Hundred Ninety Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,490,000.00) to *One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,500,000.00)* and subsequently was approved by the HoPE;

WHEREAS, the BAC proceeded with the finalization of the Request for Quotation (RFQ), send RFQ to four (4) prospective suppliers on 11 June 2018 and set the deadline of submission of Bid offer on 18 June 2018 at 5:00PM and performed the following activities:

1. send RFQ and invited four (4) prospective suppliers for negotiations, namely:
 - a) Bonifacio Motors, Inc. (Hyundai Pasig)
 - b) Prince Motor Corporation (Hyundai Commonwealth)
 - c) Motor and Carriage, Inc. (Hyundai North Edsa)
 - d) Hyundai Quezon Avenue

2. Received price quotation from the following supplier, namely;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted a meeting on 22 June 2018 at 10:00AM for the presentation of the submitted price quotations of *COMMONWEALTH/PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION, HYUNDAI QUEZON AVENUE, BONIFACIO MOTORS, INC. (HYUNDAI PASIG)* and *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)*;

WHEREAS, the BAC carefully examined and verified the accomplished price quotations submitted by *PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION (HYUNDAI COMMONWEALTH), BONIFACIO MOTORS, INC. (HYUNDAI PASIG), HYUNDAI QUEZON AVENUE* and *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* and found their offer to be RESPONSIVE:

WHEREAS, the BAC through its Secretariat verified the availability of Certificate of PHILGEPs Registration in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR of RA 9184 of *HYUNDAI QUEZON AVENUE, PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION (HYUNDAI COMMONWEALTH), BONIFACIO MOTORS, INC. (HYUNDAI PASIG)* and *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* and it was found out that *BONIFACIO MOTORS, INC. (HYUNDAI PASIG)* has no PHILGEPs Registration and subsequently declared “INELIGIBLE” by the BAC;

WHEREAS, the BAC upon verification of the submitted bid offer by *HYUNDAI QUEZON AVENUE, PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION (HYUNDAI COMMONWEALTH)* and *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* found out that they are all offering the 2017 Hyundai Starex Van and claiming that it was the latest model as per Certificate of Stock Reported (CSR) issued by the Land Transportation Office (LTO);

WHEREAS, the BAC through its Secretariat instructed the three (3) suppliers to issue a certification stating that the 2017 Hyundai Starex Van that they are offering is the latest model as per Certificate of Stock Reported (CSR) issued by the LTO to be submitted on June 26, 2018;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted a meeting on 26 June 2018 at 2:00PM for the presentation of the submitted Certification of the following prospective suppliers: 1) *HYUNDAI QUEZON AVENUE* did not submit a Certification; 2) *PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION (HYUNDAI COMMONWEALTH)* only submitted an email

thread conversation with their dealer; and 3) *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* submitted a Certification indicating that the 2017 Starex Van that they are offering is the latest model;

WHEREAS, the BAC reviewed and verified the submitted certification of the prospective suppliers and have found and declared that the Certification of *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* as ACCEPTABLE and COMPLIANT and subsequently declared *HYUNDAI QUEZON AVENUE* and *PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION (HYUNDAI COMMONWEALTH)* "INELIGIBLE";

WHEREAS, on the same meeting, the BAC instructed its Secretariat to coordinate a negotiation meeting with *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* on 29 June 2018 at 2:00PM;

WHEREAS, on 29 June 2018 at 2:00PM, in accordance with the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 the BAC undertook a negotiation with *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* to discuss clarifications with the technical and financial requirements and after the meeting the BAC requested *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* to submit its best offer on July 05, 2018;

WHEREAS, on 05 July 2018 the BAC through its Secretariat received the final offer of *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* and upon evaluation of the submitted bid quotation, found the offer of *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (LCRQ) detailed as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**;

1. To declare *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* as the bidder having the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (LCRQ) for the procurement abovementioned items; and
2. To recommend to the HoPE the award of the Purchase Order to *MOTOR AND CARRIAGE, INC. (HYUNDAI NORTH EDSA)* for having submitted the LCRQ with a contract price in the amount of *One Million Four Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (PhP 1,438,300.00)*.


