**BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) RESOLUTION DECLARING 168 SECURITY, INC., AS HAVING THE SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE ONE (1) LOT – CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF SECURITY AGENCY SERVICES FOR ELEVEN (11) MONTHS AND RECOMMENDING TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY THE APPROVAL THEREOF**

WHEREAS, there is an approved Purchase Request (P.R.) Nos. **2019-12-0351** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), in the amount of *Eighteen Million Five Hundred Sixty Six Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP 18,566,400.00)* as listed hereunder;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) was authorized to resort to Public Bidding in accordance with the provision of Rule IV, Section 10, Competitive Bidding of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act which states that all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding, except as provided in Rule XVI of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC was created in accordance with BBS Memorandum Order No. 006 series of 2018;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC convened on 09 December 2019 to conduct a pre-procurement conference with the End-User in accordance with the provision of Section 20 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 12 October 2019, the BBS-BAC as mandated by Republic Act No 9184, posted the Invitation to Bid for the Bid No. **015-19 - One (1) Lot – Contract for the Provision of Security Agency Services for eleven (11) months** in the Philippine Government Electronics Procurement System (PHILGEPS), on conspicuous place at the premises of the BBS and posted the same in the website of the Bureau of Broadcast Services;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, one (1) prospective bidder viewed the Invitation to Bid at the PHILGEPS Website namely; 1) 168 SECURITY, INC.;

WHEREAS, for the purposes of transparency and good governance and pursuant to Section 13 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invited three (3) observers to witness the pre-bid conference on 25 October 2019 and the opening of bids on 06 November 2019 namely; MR. CRISANTO FRIANEZA, Secretary General of Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, ENGR. VIRGILIO S. SANTOS, President of Procurement Watch and MS. ANNABELLE F. DE VERA, State Auditor III/Audit Team Leader in BBS of Commission on Audit;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC scheduled the Pre-Bid Conference on 19 December 2019 at 11:00AM in order that the BBS-BAC may clarify issues which the prospective bidders might raise, the said Pre-Bid Conference was attended by one (1) prospective bidder, namely; 1) 168 SECURITY, INC.;

**WHEREAS**, one (1) prospective bidder namely; 1) 168 SECURITY, INC., purchased the Bidding Document;

**WHEREAS**, on 03 December 2020 at 1:00PM, the BBS-BAC scheduled the Opening of Bids, 168 SECURITY, INC., attended and submitted its Eligibility and Technical Components Documents as well as its Financial Component Document before the 1:00pm deadline and simultaneously, the BAC conducted the Opening of Bids;

**WHEREAS**, the BBS-BAC proceeded to open the Eligibility and Technical Documents envelope of 168 SECURITY, INC., its itemized contents were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector and found to have passed and sufficient and was declared "ELIGIBLE";

**WHEREAS**, the bidding process was completed and the BBS-BAC proceeded to open the Financial Component Document of 168 SECURITY, INC, in the amount of Eighteen Million Three Hundred Eighty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty Eight Pesos and 90/100 Centavos (PhP 18,389,738.90) and was declared by the BBS-BAC as the SINGLE RESPONSIVE BID (SRB);

**WHEREAS**, on the same meeting, the BBS-BAC Secretariat officially turned-over to the BAC TWG a copy of the Eligibility and Technical Documents as well as the financial document of 168 SECURITY, INC., for bid evaluation;

**WHEREAS**, the BAC Chairman informed 168 SECURITY, INC., to submit their Post-Qualification Documents within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days;

**WHEREAS**, on 06 January 2020, 168 SECURITY, INC., submitted to the BBS-BAC Secretariat their Post-Qualification Documents as listed in the Bidding Document

**WHEREAS**, on the same day, the BAC-TWG informed the BBS-BAC that based on their evaluation conducted in the eligibility documents of the 168 SECURITY, INC., it was discovered that it has "PASSED" the bid evaluation, subsequently the BBS-BAC selected the composite group of BBS-BAC, TWG and Secretariat who will conduct the post-qualification stage on 10 January 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the composite group of selected BAC, TWG and Secretariat on 08 January 2020 at 9:30AM, proceeded to the office of 168 SECURITY, INC., in Caloocan City and conducted the post qualification inspection of its Eligibility and Technical Components Documents and Post Qualification Documents and counterchecked the same with the original documents. The team likewise inspected the office premises;

**WHEREAS**, the BBS-BAC Post-Qualification Composite Group verified and validated the Post-Qualification Requirements of 168 SECURITY, INC., and all were found to be true and correct and in accordance with the requirements and inspection activities and the BBS-BAC declared that it has "PASSED" the post-qualification stage;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, foregoing premises considered, we the members of the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC), hereby **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to declare 168 SECURITY, INC., as having the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) for the Contract for the Provision of Security Agency Services for eleven (11) months for all Bureau of Broadcast services (BBS) facilities nationwide (NCR, CAR, Region I,II, II, IV, V,VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII and ARMM), provided that the Bidder had dispatched guards in at least ten (10) different regions of the country.; and

**RESOLVE FURTHER**, that the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) recommends to the Approving Authority the approval of this resolution, the subsequent issuance of the Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and Contract of Services with 168 SECURITY, INC., for the Contract for the Provision of Security Agency Services for eleven (11) months for all Bureau of Broadcast services (BBS) facilities nationwide (NCR, CAR, Region I,II, II, IV, V,VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII and ARMM), provided that the Bidder had dispatched guards in at least ten (10) different regions of the country – fifty six (56) security guards in the amount of **EIGHTEEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT PESOS AND 90/100 CENTAVOS (PhP 18,389,738.90)** in accordance with the provisions of the signed Purchase Order and the Guidelines under the Government Procurement Reform Act, as approved and adopted by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB).






