BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) RESOLUTION DECLARING TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. AS HAVING THE SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE ONE (1) LOT — SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BRAND-NEW MOTOR VEHICLES AND RECOMMENDING TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY THE APPROVAL THEREOF

WHEREAS, there is an approved Purchase Request (P.R.) No. 2022-03-00086 with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **Seven Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 7,200,000,00)** at listed bereunder:

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) was authorized to resort to Public Bidding in accordance with the provision of Rule IV, Section 10, Competitive Bidding of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act which states that all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding, except as provided in Rule XVI of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC was created in accordance with BBS Memorandum Order No. 006 series of 2018;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC convened on 23 February 2022 and 02 March 2022 at the BBS Training Room to conduct a preprocurement conference with the End-User in accordance with the provision of Section 20 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 07 March 2022, the BBS-BAC as mandated by Republic Act No 9184, posted the Invitation to Bid for the One (1) Lot - Supply and Delivery of Brand New Motor Vehicles (Bid No. 001-2022) in the Philippine Government Electronics Procurement System (PHILGEPS), on conspicuous place at the premises of the BBS and posted the same in the website of the Bureau of Broadcast

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, ten (10) prospective bidders viewed the Invitation to Bid at the PHILGEPS Website namely; 1) Genesis Auto Corp., 2) Nissan Commonwealth, Inc., 3) Manindra Auto Corp. (Foton Isabela), 4) The Big IDepot, Inc., 5) Manindra Auto Corp., 6) SJ Legacy Motors, Inc., 7) Elite North Autocars, 8) Toyota Pasong Tamo, Inc., 9) Toyota Global City, Incorporated and 10) JROG Marketing;

WHEREAS, on 09 March 2022 for the purposes of transparency and good governance and pursuant to Section 10 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invited three (3) observers to witness the pre-bid conference and the opening of bids, namely; MR. CRISANTO FRIANEZA, Secretary General of Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, ENGR. VIRGILIO S. SANTOS, President of Procurement Watch and MR. EDGARDO L. RIVERA, State Auditor III/Audit Team Leader in BBS of Commission on Audit;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC scheduled the Pre-Bid Conference on 15 March 2022, 10:00am at the BBS Training Room in order that the BBS-BAC may clarify issues which the prospective bidder/s might raise. Four (4) prospective bidders attended the pre-bid conference namely; 1) TOYOTA PASONG TAMO, 2) TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, 3) TOYOTA NORTH EDSA and 4) MCX INTERNATIONAL;

WHEREAS, on 17 March 2022 based on the issues raised by prospective bidders during the pre-bid conference, the BBS-BAC issued Supplemental Bid Bulletin No. 001-2022 to revise several provisions of Section VI, Schedule of Requirements and Section VII, Technical Specifications to wit:

WHEREAS, two (2) bidders namely; 1) TOYOTA PASONG TAMO and 2) TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. purchased the Bidding Document;

WHEREAS, on 28 March 2022 at 10:00am, the BBS-BAC scheduled the Opening of Bids, TOYOTA PASONG TAMO and TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. physically attended and submitted their Eligibility and Technical Components Documents as well as their Financial Component Document before the 10:00am deadline and simultaneously, the BAC conducted the Opening of Bids;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC first opened the Eligibility and Technical Components Documents of TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. and after its itemized content were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector, the BBS-BAC found the eligibility and technical components documents to have PASSED and was declared ELIGIBLE;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC proceeded to open the Eligibility and Technical Documents envelope of TOYOTA PASONG TAMO, its itemized contents were read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector, during the course of the evaluation, it was discovered that it failed on one (1) of its eligibility requirements, under Section VII, Technical Specification, Item C. Others, 1) Certificate under oath that the supplier shall facilitate processing of the one (1) year Comprehensive Insurance through the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) which shall be paid for by the Bureau of Broadcast Services ((BBS). (To be submitted during the opening of bids.) Note: To attach photocopy of affiant's I.D."

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC declared TOYOTA PASONG TAMO to have FAILED and was INELIGIBLE for submitting a patently insufficient document. The BBS-BAC informed the bidder from TOYOTA PASONG TAMO that they may file for a motion for reconsideration within three (3) calendar days upon receipt of the notice the BAC;

WHEREAS, TOYOTA PASONG TAMO informed the BBS-BAC that they are waiving their rights to file for a Motion for Reconsideration, subsequently the BBS-BAC asked the representative of TOYOTA PASONG TAMO to write a waiver and submit it to the BAC Secretariat;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC opened the Financial Component Document of TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. and was read aloud and subsequently shown thru the multi-media projector with a financial bid In the amount of *Six Million Nine Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 6,943,500.00)* and was declared by the BBS-BAC as SINGLE RESPONSIVE BID (SRB);

**WHEREAS**, after the declaration of SRB, the BAC Secretariat officially turned-over to the BAC TWG the Eligibility and Technical Documents as well as the Financial Component Document of TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. for evaluation;

**WHEREAS**, on the same meeting, the BBS-BAC informed the bidder from TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. to submit their Post-Qualification Documents within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC discussed the parameters of the post-qualification activity and the BBS-BAC shall create a composite group of BBS-BAC, TWG and Secretariat who will conduct the post-qualification stage to TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC.;

WHEREAS, the BAC Secretariat informed the representative of TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC., that a composite group of BAC, TWG & Secretariat will conduct a post-qualification stage at their office on 31 March 2022'

WHEREAS, the composite group of selected BAC, TWG and Secretariat on 31 March 2022 at 10:00AM, proceeded to the office of TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. and conducted the post qualification inspection of its Eligibility and Technical Components Documents and Post Qualification Documents and counterchecked the same with the presented original documents;

**WHEREAS**, on the same day, after all the eligibility and technical components documents and post-qualification documents were verified and validated and all were found to be true and correct and in accordance with the requirements and inspection activities. The BBS-BAC Post-Qualification Composite Group declared TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC., to have PASSED the post-qualification requirements and inspection activities;

**WHEREAS**, the composite group submitted to the BBS-BAC the accomplished Checklist of Post-Qualification Requirements, which were all been verified and validated and all were found to be true and correct. The financial document was likewise reviewed and found to be in order and in compliance with the provisions of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184;

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, we the members of the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC), hereby RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to declare TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE, INC. as having the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB) for the One (1) Lot – Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Motor Vehicles (Five (5) Units – Brand-New Multi-Purpose Vehicle and One (1) Unit – Brand-New Pick-Up Vehicle); and

**RESOLVE FURTHER**, that the Bureau of Broadcast Services-Bids and Awards Committee (BBS-BAC) recommends to the Approving Authority the approval of this resolution, the subsequent issuance of the Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed and Purchase Order with **TOYOTA QUEZON AVENUE**, **INC.** for the **One (1) Lot — Supply and Delivery of Brand New Motor Vehicles** in the amount of **Six Million Nine Hundred Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 6,943,500.00)** in accordance with the provisions of the signed Purchase Order and the Guidelines under the Government Procurement Reform Act, as approved and adopted by the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB).
