BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) RESOLUTION DECLARING COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC. AS THE TECHNICALLY, LEGALLY AND FINANCIALLY CAPABLE SUPPLIER AND RECOMMENDING TO THE APPROVING AUTHORITY THE APPROVAL THEREOF

WHEREAS, there is an approved *Job Order (J.O.) No. 2024-07-0061* with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of ***Seven Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos (PhP 779,464.00)*** for the procurement of the following items below;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created in accordance with BBS Special Order No. 046 series of 2024 dated 31 May 2024;

WHEREAS, the said *purchase request/job order* is included in the Annual Procurement Plan of the Presidential Broadcast Service- Bureau of Broadcast Services (PBS-BBS) for 2024;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee was authorized to resort to alternative method of procurement in accordance with provision of Article XVI, Section 50; which states that **DIRECT CONTRACTING** or single source procurement is a method of procurement of goods that does not require elaborate Bidding Documents. The supplier is simply asked to submit a price quotation or a pro-forma invoice together with the condition of sale. The offer may be accepted immediately or after some negotiations. Direct Contracting may be resorted under any of the following conditions:

- Procurement of goods of proprietary nature which can be obtained only from the proprietary source, i.e., when patents, trade secrets, and copyrights prohibit others from manufacturing the same item;
- When the procurement of critical components from a specific supplier is a condition precedent to hold a contractor to guarantee its project performance, in accordance with the provisions of its contract; or
- Those sold by an exclusive dealer or manufacturer which does not have sub-dealers selling at lower prices and for which no suitable substitute can be obtained at more advantageous terms to the government.

WHEREAS, to justify the need to procure through the Direct Contracting method, the End-User should conduct a survey of the industry and determine the supply source. In all cases where Direct Contracting is contemplated, the survey must be conducted prior to the commencement of the procurement process. Moreover, the End-User must justify the necessity for an item that may only be procured through Direct Contracting, and it must be able to prove that there is no suitable substitute in the market that can be obtained at more advantageous terms.

WHEREAS, the End-User conducted a survey to determine the probable supplier that can supply the item/s and could undertake the procurement through direct contracting and considered **COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC.** as the probable direct supplier;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC received from the End-User the purchase request/job order and other appropriate document/s that will justify the necessity of the item to be procured and confirming the existence and veracity of the grounds to resort to Direct Contracting procurement;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC upon review of the submitted documents of the End-User recommended to the HOPE the mode of procurement and execute the said request;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC agreed to proceed with the finalization of the Request for Quotation (RFQ) together with the terms and conditions of the procurement and send the same to the identified probable supplier of the end-user;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC undertook a negotiation with **COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC.** to determine that the supplier is technically, legally and financially capable to deliver the Goods at the most advantageous price and contract;

WHEREAS, **COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC.** submitted their accomplished RFQ with a financial offer in the amount of ***Seven Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos (PhP 779,464.00) VAT inclusive*** and other required documents;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC reviewed and verified the submitted financial and technical documents submitted **COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC.** and have found the offer acceptable and compliant;

WHEREAS, the BBS-BAC likewise reviewed and verified the Documentary Requirements listed in Appendix A of Annex H of the Updated 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 and have found the documents in order and in compliance with the provisions of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184;

NOW THEREFORE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**;

1. To declare **COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC.** as the supplier that is technically, legally and financially capable to perform the above-mentioned requirement for the procurement of the abovementioned items; and
2. To recommend to the HOPE the award of the Letter Order to **COMPOSITE TECHNOLOGY, INC.** for having submitted the SCRQ with a contract price in the amount of **Seven Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Pesos (PhP 779,464.00)**.
